- \* A double room is 2 people in the same room. If you do not list a roommate we will assign one. Both roommates' registrations must be in before a room is assigned.

- \*Wireless internet available in all lodging areas.
- \*All lodging rooms must be vacated by **9 am Thursday May 1, 2025**. Camp continues till 3pm for hooking and learning.

Housing Information: Please bring your own toiletries. All lodgers are given 1 bath towel, 1 hand towel, and 1 washcloth. All bed linens are provided. Each room has 1 bath mat. If you need or want additional towels, please bring your own. All Beds have a protective covering, if this will bother you, please bring a mattress pad cover, twin or queen. Each lodge room contains 1 twin and 1 Queen bed for sleeping, discuss with roommate what bed you are getting and bring pad accordingly. RV's self-contained no housekeeping services. Pets, Alcohol are not permitted, service animal exception. Smoking allowed outside only. Please alert Director for special Dietary needs or severe food allergies.

## Fees as listed below are all inclusive for Camp.

<u>Aldersgate Lodge Double</u> - Total fee **\$635 Rug Hooker**/**\$510** non-hooking companion (all meals included for companion). After deposit of \$275 balance due February 1 is \$360/\$235. A \$275 deposit required non-hooking companion.

Two people required per room.

Aldersgate Lodge Rug Retreat office and one class will be located in the Fireside Room. The dining room is also located in Aldersgate Lodge, all meals and the Hooking Flea Market will be in the Aldersgate Lodge. All *lodging* rooms contain a sink and vanity with a separate shower/toilet room, one queen bed, one twin bed, and one desk. A limited number of clothes hangers are provided.

Two Classrooms, break room and the Birch Bay Rug Hooking Store will be located in the Oakwood Auditorium rooms A B C D. Main Auditorium room will be closed. Beverages and snacks will be located: Fireside room and entry way Oakwood Auditorium. 10am.

<u>RV Spaces</u> - \$535 per hooking student(s)/\$75 per non-hooking companion with no meals or \$250 with all meals. After deposit of \$275 per Hooking Student(s)/\$75 non-hooking companion deposit, balance due February 1 is \$260 Hooking student(s)/\$0 non-hooking companion with no meals/\$175 with all meals. RV offers full hook ups and bathroom facility building. RV Spaces are located a short, level walk from the main facilities. Number of RV spaces available 6.
